No. 25-2009 H & N Maurer SE 23-6-4E Roll No. 110275 Complaint: Assessment too high due to small hog operation with no expansion allowed in the current zone. Decision: That the Class 12 land and building assessments be confirmed at \$1,400 and \$139,600 for a total Class 12 assessment of \$141,000 and that the Class 30 land and building assessments be confirmed at \$16,500 and \$516,100 for a total Class 30 assessment of \$532,600.
