

**Red River Weed Control District
2020 PROPOSED PESTICIDE PROGRAM**

Public Notice is hereby given that the Red River Weed Control District intends to conduct their pesticide program within the Municipalities of DeSalaberry and Ritchot and Village of St Pierre Jolys.

To control noxious weeds within the district, the products in the allowable list as per MB regulation 286/2014 plus the following will/may be used between May 1st and November 1st, 2020.

- 2-4-D Amine 600
- Glyphosate
- 2-4-D Ester LV 700
- Amitrol
- Aminopyralid
- Surfactants are N-phuric, Li700 and Hasten NT
- Fiesta
- Dicamba
- Adios
- Finalsan

To control pests including grasshoppers, elm bark beetle, forest tent caterpillars, cankerworms, mosquitoes and other pests within the district, the following insecticides will/may be used between May 1st and November 1st, 2020.

- Ripcord
- Aquabec 200g
- Malathion
- Decis
- Dimethosphate
- Foray
- Pyrate
- Vectobec
